## Serving With Red Cross

Laura Riskedahl, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Clifford Riskedahl, Tuttle, has completed a training session in Washington, D. C., and is now an active member of the DuNang SRO Unit of the American National Red Cross in South Vietnam. In this capacity she serves as Recreation Aide, a link with the "world" for our fighting men in Vietnam. Among her duties Miss Riskedahl brings recreation program to the support bases and forward areas throughout I Corps the northern region of South Vietnam.

After a year of teaching in Anoka, Minn., Miss Riskedahl joined the Supplemental Recreational Activities Overseas program. She will spend 12 months in different areas of Southeast Asia, raising the morale of servicemen. She began her tour of duty on July 30th when she left Washington, D. C., in a group of 20 girls from throughout the nation. The same day a group of 10 who had been in the same training session also left for Korea.

Miss Riskedahl is a 1970 graduate of Jamestown College. She plans to return to teaching after spending one year working for the American Red Cross.
