## HILDA E. HINKEL

Hilda E. Hinkel, 10790 Colorado Road, Rancho Cordova, California, died Sunday, July 12, 1987, at the Carmichael Convalescent Hospital in Sacramento, California.

She was born June 15, 1909, on a farm three miles east of Arena, North Dakota, the daughter of Eberhard and Mathilda (Freeh) Sauter. She was raised on the farm and attended rural school, graduating from the Tuttle High School in 1930.

When she was 12 years old, she started working in the General Store in Tuttle.

Hilda married William Earl Hinkel of Tuttle. Following their marriage they lived in Tuttle where Hilda worked as an assistant postmaster and acting postmaster during World War II.

In 1950, they moved to Jamestown where she worked for J.C. Penney until her retirement.

Mr. Hinkel died on July 10, 1983. Following his death, Hilda lived in Bismarck for several years before moving to California in 1978.
