

Lynora Scherbenske, long-time Tuttle resident, died on Oct. 13, 2007. Services will be held at 11 a.m., Thursday, Oct. 18, at Tuttle United Methodist Church. Burial will be at the Tuttle Community Cemetery following the service.

Lynora was born on the Sauter family farm in Tuttle on Oct. 21, 1924. She was the daughter of Eberhardt and Mathilda Sauter. Lynora attended school in Tuttle, graduating from Tuttle High School in 1942.

On Nov. 19, 1943, Lynora married Art Scherbenske. They lived on the Scherbenske homestead until building a home just west of the Tuttle School in 1952.

Lynora was an active member of the Tuttle United Methodist Church, serving as pianist and organist for many years. She especially enjoyed the years of accompanying the Men's Chorus and the Men's Quartet. She also served as clerk of the Tuttle School Board for several years, worked at the Tuttle Dairy and enjoyed the family greenhouse and gardening. Visiting with friends and neighbors who came to purchase plants at the greenhouse was a pleasant part of spring for many years. Lynora enjoyed watching baseball and basketball. She attended the World Series when the Twins played in 1965. Lynora and Art spent many hours watching baseball and basketball on television during their retirement years. Art and Lynora traveled with friends and family to Europe, Asia, Australia and many U.S. states.
